LETTER FROM THE BOARD

GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE NEW SHARES

Pursuant to an ordinary resolution passed by the Shareholders on 27 June 2018, a general unconditional mandate was given to the Directors to exercise powers of the Company to issue Shares with an aggregate nominal value not exceeding the sum of (i) 20% of the share capital of the Company in issue as at the date of passing the relevant resolution; and (ii) the aggregate nominal amount of any share capital of the Company repurchased. Such mandate will expire at the conclusion of the forthcoming Annual General Meeting. As at the Latest Practicable Date, no Shares have been issued or allotted under such mandate since 27 June 2018.

An ordinary resolution will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to grant a general and unconditional mandate to the Directors to allot, issue and deal with, at any time until the next annual general meeting of the Company following the passing of the Issue Mandate (as hereinafter defined) or such earlier date as stated therein, Shares not exceeding 20% of the issued share capital of the Company at the date of passing of the resolution (the “**Issue Mandate**”) and to extend the Issue Mandate by adding to it the number of Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate (as defined below). RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

In accordance with articles 86(3) and 87 of the Articles as well as the Corporate Governance Code and Corporate Governance Report as set out in Appendix 14 to the Listing Rules, Mr. Wang Yan, Mr. Yin Jianhong, Ms. Yang Yuhua, Mr. Fan Ren-Da, Anthony, Mr. Leung Chung Ki and Mr. Tang Hon Man (together, “**Retiring Directors**”) will retire at the Annual General Meeting and be eligible for re-election by the Shareholders. All of the Retiring Directors will offer themselves for re-election by the Shareholders.

In which, Mr. Fan Ren-Da, Anthony has served the Board for more than 9 years and holds more than seven listed company directorships as independent non-executive directors as at the Latest Practicable Date. Over the past 10 years, the Board received from Mr. Fan Ren-Da, Anthony his annual confirmation of independence pursuant to Rule 3.13 of the Listing Rules and considered him as independent. Possessing extensive working experience and knowledge and in-depth understanding of the Company’s operations and business, Mr. Fan Ren-Da, Anthony has expressed objective views and given independent opinion to the Company over the years, and he continues demonstrating a firm commitment to his role. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 57,155,930,569 Shares. Subject to the passing of the Repurchase Resolution at the Annual General Meeting and on the basis that no further Shares are issued or repurchased prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting, the Company would be allowed to repurchase a maximum of 5,715,593,056 Shares under the Repurchase Mandate, being 10% of the issued share capital of the Company.

REASONS FOR REPURCHASE

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the best interests of the Company and the Shareholders. Whilst it is not possible to anticipate in advance any specific circumstance in which the Directors might think it appropriate to repurchase Shares, they believe that an ability to do so would give the Company additional flexibility that would be beneficial to the Company and the Shareholders as such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value of the Company and/or its earnings per Share. Such repurchases will only be made as and when the Directors believe that such repurchases will benefit the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

If the Directors exercise the Repurchase Mandate in full to repurchase 5,715,593,056 Shares, and assuming that there is no alteration to the existing shareholding of Mr. Dai Yongge's personal interest and interest of his spouse together with his interest in the Company through Super Brilliant, Wealthy Aim and Gloss Season, Mr. Dai Yongge's long and short positions in the Company will increase to approximately 57.21% and 0.13% respectively.

If the Directors exercise the Repurchase Mandate in full to repurchase 5,715,593,056 Shares, and assuming that there is no alteration to the existing shareholding of Ms. Zhang Xingmei's interest from her spouse together with her interest in the Company through New Amuse, Ms. Zhang Xingmei's long and short positions in the Company will increase to approximately 57.21% and 0.13% respectively.

From October 2011 to May 2014, he served as director of China Merchants Securities Investment Management (HK) Co., Limited, CMS Capital (HK) Co., Limited and China Merchants Nominees (HK) Co., Limited. From March 2005 to September 2011, he served as executive president and chief operating officer, acting chief executive officer, and executive president and chief executive officer of BOC International Holdings Limited. From April 2000 to January 2005, he served as deputy general manager of the Hong Kong branch of Industrial and Commercial Bank of China Limited ("**ICBC**") (the securities of which are listed on SSE with stock code: 601398 and the Main Board of the Stock Exchange with stock code: 1398). During such period, Mr. Wang also served as deputy general manager and alternative chief executive officer of Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (Asia) Limited (the securities of which were listed on the Main Board of the Stock Exchange with stock code: 349 but subsequently completed privatization in December 2010) from July 2001 to December 2004. From February 1997 to April 2000, he served as representative and chief representative of the New York representative office of ICBC.
